Denton Club President Sonja Rogers expressed how wonderful it was to have spent a day becoming friends with the GSE team. Team leader Fernando Liz accepted a gift from the club saying his feelings were overwhelming. “Who can express? Rotary is feeling, really.”

Sponsored by the Rotary Foundation of Rotary International, the team will be in the district through May 9 and will attend the district assembly on April 26. In addition to Denton, they will spend time in Weatherford, Mineral Wells, Fort Worth, Abilene, and Arlington.

The team members include Leslier Valenzuela, a university professor who teaches marketing and business management; Patricia Fernandez, a social worker; Luis Inostroza, an agricultural engineer; and Edith Asencio, a university English professor.

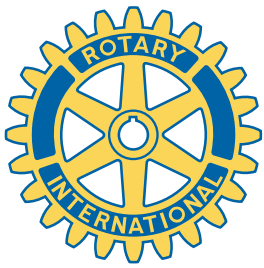
