Technology, Travel, Textbooks

Our featured speaker this week is Herman Oosterwijk, Nicaragua project coordinator of our club. As you can see from his name, and hear from his accent, Herman is not a native Texan, but was born and raised in the Netherlands where he met his lovely wife Johanna. As a young family with three beautiful girls, they decided to cross the ocean to look for more space and opportunities in the USA as a corporate transfer for Philips Medical Systems.

Fifteen years ago, after Kodak brought him and his family in the Dallas area, he decided to start his own consulting and training business, "OTech," together with Johanna. His company allows him to travel extensively to teach both hospital and vendor professionals in Healthcare IT how to develop and support the communication between imaging devices such as CT, MRI, Ultrasound, and others.

This year's seminars and workshops included places in Germany, the Netherlands, Dubai, Bangalore and several U.S. locations. Herman published a couple of textbooks on the subjects he teaches (one of which is translated in Japanese and Spanish), presents at several conferences (this year in San Antonio, Vancouver, and

Athens) and publishes his own e-newsletter for thousands of professionals.

Herman's passion is healthcare, and having an engineering background, he spent almost his entire career with medical imaging. As part of his teaching, he comes in contact with many state-of-the-art technologies, of which he is going to share with us in his presentation on new imaging technologies.

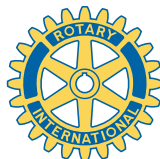
NEW Highland Village Rotary Club!

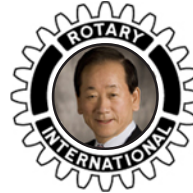

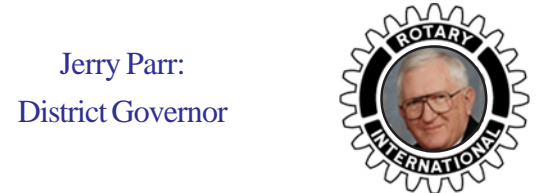

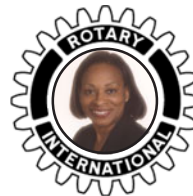
