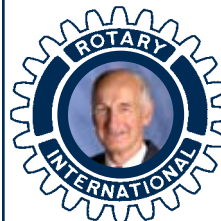

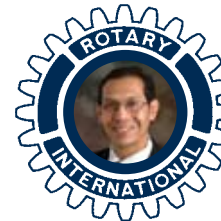

World Interact Week

World Interact Week 2006 was a tremendous success! Interact clubs throughout the world, in partnership with their sponsoring Rotary clubs, participated in a wide array of service projects and activities:

- In response to a blood bank shortage, the Interact Club of Brasov, Romania promoted the importance of blood donation in their community.
- When they discovered a local hospital had no toys for its young patients, the Interact Club of Hoërskool Schoonspruit, South Africa sponsored a toy drive.
- Both the Interact Clubs of Sri Sankara Vidyasharamam and Parimalam, India focused their efforts on AIDS education to help fight the spread of the disease.
- The Interact Club of Gan Yavne, Israel reached out to less fortunate youth in their community by sponsoring a camp for local children.
- In partnership with their local media, the Interact Club of San Luis, Argentina promoted drug and alcohol-free living to the youth of their community.
- U.S. Interactors at Syosset High School, with the support of their classmates and community, raised funds to provide two children with life-saving heart surgery.
- The Interact Club of Tuloy sa Donsco, Philippines helped organize and facilitate a conference where local Interact and Rotaract clubs were able to fellowship and exchange ideas.

In addition to these efforts, clubs made notable contributions in areas ranging from literacy to hunger relief to the environment. We look forward to even greater participation in 2007.

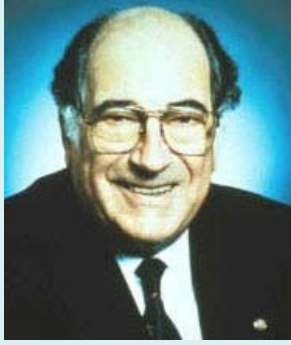

Robert R. Barth, who served as president of Rotary International during 1993-94, died on 29 March 2007.

A Rotarian since 1956, Barth was a member of the Rotary Club of Aarau, Switzerland. The RI theme he selected for 1993-94 was Believe in What You Do – Do What You Believe In.

Barth also served Rotary as district governor, information institute counselor, RI training leader, committee member and chair, Foundation trustee and chair, director, and treasurer. In addition, he was an RI representative to the United Nations in Geneva. He was a recipient of the Polio-Plus Pioneer Award and The Rotary Foundation's Distinguished Service Award for his extraordinary service to PolioPlus.

A beverage industry executive, Barth was president of Robarth Holding AG, former president of CESDA (Confederation of European Soft Drink Manufacturers), and former chair of the Swiss Sport Aid Foundation. He served in the Chamber of Commerce and Industries of Aarau.

Funeral services will be held at 14:00, Wednesday, 4 April 2007 in the Gemeindesaal, Breitenstrasse 14, CH-4852, Rothrist, Switzerland. Attendees are requested to arrive early, preferably close to 12:00. Barth is survived by his wife, Gerty, his two sons, Alexander and Daniel, and daughter, Christine, and their families.
