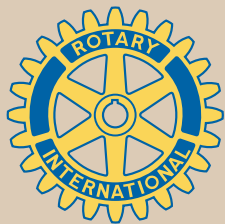

Rotary International News

1. RI theme

RI President John Kenny reminded Rotarians that *The Future of Rotary Is in Your Hands*, unveiling the 2009-10 RI theme during the International Assembly in January.



2. Gates Foundation grants

Bill Gates announced in January a new award of \$255 million in support of Rotary's campaign to rid the world of polio, raising the amount committed by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation to \$355 million. Rotary has pledged to raise \$200 million in response.

3. Polio fundraisers

Rotarians' can-do spirit fueled a variety of creative and successful polio fundraisers, ranging from national campaigns in Austria and Germany on World Polio Day to the Concert to End Polio on 2 December, helping push Rotary past the halfway mark in meeting the challenge. "In the face of difficult economic times, Rotarians are heartily commended for their steadfast commitment and resourcefulness in reaching this milestone of support for global polio eradication," said Rotary Foundation Trustee Chair Glenn E. Estess Sr



4. Future Vision

Diversity played a key role in the June selection of 100 districts for the Future Vision pilot. The three-year pilot will test a new, streamlined Rotary Foundation grant structure and is set to begin in July 2010. Rotarians in pilot districts can join a LinkedIn group to discuss project ideas, share best practices, and learn from each other's efforts.

5. President-nominee

Kalyan Banerjee, a member of the Rotary Club of Vapi, Gujarat, India, since 1972, became the RI president-nominee in October. He will serve as 2011-12 RI president.

Five Years After the Tsunami

Five years after a powerful tsunami devastated communities along the coast of the Indian Ocean, Rotary projects continue to contribute to long-term recovery.

Shortly after the tsunami hit on 26 December 2004, The Rotary Foundation established a Solidarity in South Asia fund, coordinating US\$5.9 million in donations toward recovery efforts throughout the region. The Foundation also awarded more than \$480,000 in humanitarian grants in India, Indonesia, Sri Lanka, and Thailand. Many individual Rotary club and district foundations also contributed from their own funds.

RI President John Kenny visited Banda Aceh, Indonesia, in late November to inaugurate one result of those recovery projects: a health center that is part of a larger \$1.9 million youth complex on about an acre of donated land.

The two-story health center occupies 5,860 square yards of land in the nearby village of Khaju, set aside by government officials who were impressed by the mobilization of Rotarian volunteers in the days after the tsunami. The facility joins an orphanage that opened three years ago, dedicated to child survivors of the disaster. A two-story dormitory for university students is under construction. Water purification and treatment systems serve the entire complex.
