Harold brings 27 years of training and development experience to the industry, 17 years of which he has taught memory training specifically. Harold, a psychologist educated at the University of Texas, spent 13 years with ARCO Oil & Gas Company as Director of Training and Development in the Operations and Engineering division before joining Memory Training Institute in 1989. After setting industry

records as the fastest memory instructor ever to be certified, he was appointed President of the Memory Training Institute, Inc. In 1995 he created Memory Technologies Institute and began expanding the training paradigm to include a multi-faceted training company within the industry.

Harold, over the past 17 years, has conducted workshops at corporations including Texas Instruments, J.C.Penney, AT&T, Shell Oil, Johnson & Johnson, 3M, Xerox, Bausch & Lomb, Eastman Kodak, Schlumberger, GTE, Motorola, IBM, Sun Micro Systems, and many more. Harold resides in Dallas, Texas with his wife and two daughters and oversees the day to day operations of Memory Technologies Institute.

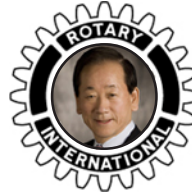

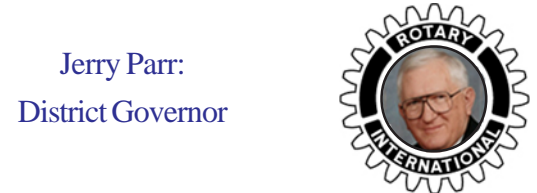
