### New mayor addresses club

Newly elected Mayor Mark Burroughs, who took office June 17 after a hotly contested run-off election, will be the featured speaker at Denton Rotary's July 24 meeting.

Burroughs, a former president of Denton Rotary, won 62 percent of the run-off vote, soundly defeating incumbent Perry McNeill. Having served as councilman at large from 1998 to 2004 and mayor pro tem 2002-2004, Burroughs has targeted managing Denton's rapid growth and involving residents in decision-making as priorities for the city.

"I want to make sure we create a city that is protective of the neighborhoods while welcoming the advantages that this growth

we are seeing right now can provide," he said. "It's a challenge, and it takes energy and it takes creativity. But that's why I ran."

A graduate of Stephen F. Austin State University and the University of Texas Law School, Burroughs is a partner in the Denton law firm Sawko & Burroughs, L.L.P., formed in 1994. He and his wife Annie have two children.

Burroughs has been a member of the Denton County Transportation Authority board of directors. He is also president of the Greater Denton Arts Council and vice chairman of the Denton Chamber of Commerce.

## Club assembly kicks off new year

Members of Denton Rotary enjoyed a glimpse of the club's plans for the coming year during the first club assembly held July 17. Directors and committee chairs described upcoming activities and projects, and members had the opportunity to volunteer for service in a wide variety of areas.

Among the club's activities during the coming year will be:

- The annual Mardi Gras fund-raiser, with an ambitious goal of \$30,000, up 25 percent from last year, funding club scholarships and service activities.
- A renewed emphasis on the eradication of polio with the PolioPlus project, chaired by Rob Seay.
- A possible industrial expo, featuring local industries and a job fair, as a project of the Vocation at Work committee chaired by Karen Dickson.
- A Club Family committee, focused on developing closer relationships among members and communicating about members' milestone celebrations and chaired by Condell Garden.
- An emphasis on membership development, led by John Shrader and Jack Cross.
- Expanded World Community Service outreach, with more teams working on water projects in Mexico with Horace Brock and Stan Ingman, and clinics in Nicaragua with Herman Oosterwijk.
- Community service projects determined by a vote of the membership. (See ballot in today's *Flywheel*.)

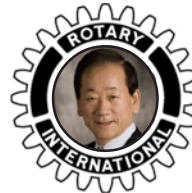

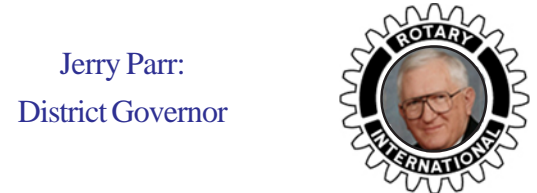
