District Governor Miller to speak



District 5790 Governor John A. Miller will address the Denton Rotary Club this coming Thursday. We're honored to have the DG take the time to share his vision for District 5790 and the future of Rotary.

John was born and grew up in Bristol, Virginia-Tennessee, where his ancestors go back to the 1700's among the original settlers of that area. He received his BS degree in Business Administration from the University of Tennessee in Knoxville along with a commission in the U.S. Air Force. Later he completed graduate studies at West Texas A&M University in Canyon.

While serving on active duty with the Air Force during the Vietnam War, he was stationed for two years near Nashville, then a year in Turkey on the Black Sea and finally in Kansas as squadron commander. After

release from active duty John entered the corporate world, first working as the corporate transportation manager for Eastern Air Lines in Miami, then with Ryder System in Miami who moved his family in 1980 to Plano, Texas. In 1990 John and his wife opened an entrepreneurial business in Colorado Springs only to close it two years later and move to Amarillo where he joined with former business associates in a logistics consulting enterprise. In 1994 they moved to Arlington where he still works as a part-time distribution consultant.

In the early 1990's John joined the Rotary Club of Colorado Springs and was a member for the two years they lived there. In the winter of 2000 he joined the Rotary Club of Arlington North and has served on numerous committees, as well as being Club Secretary and President. John and Claire have hosted a Rotary exchange student from Poland and also hosted a Productivity Enhancement Program (PEP) of 13 Russians. He has been honored as his club's Rotarian of the Year and his wife Claire has been inducted as an honorary member of the club. John has served as Assistant Governor to the seven Arlington clubs for three years and has been recognized as the Assistant Governor of the Year. Having been actively involved with the Wheelchair Foundation, he twice traveled with other District 5790 Rotarians to Mexico on a friendship exchange and helped the Rotarians of Leon deliver over 800 wheelchairs. John and Claire are both Paul Harris Fellows. John is a member of the Paul Harris Society and also a Benefactor to The Rotary Foundation.

John and Claire have two children: a daughter who teaches third grade in Euless and a son who is deceased.

Rotary Notes

In Rotary, wherever you are, you are welcomed by friends. The most recent example of this was demonstrated while our fellow member, Tim Mangrum was in Tunica making arrangements for his grandmother's funeral. He exchanged banners with the Rotary Club in the town where he was born.

The club welcomed him with traditional warm Mississippi hospitality and honored the memory of his grandparents who were small business owners and life-long members of the community. Rotary friends are everywhere.
