As the president and chief executive officer of United Way of Denton County, **Lilia Chávez Bynum** brings a broad corporate, non-profit and community involvement background. Bynum, who spoke at last week's Rotary Club meeting, began her career with United Way in 1997, as resource development director of United Way of Denton County. She then served as resource development director for Texas Woman's University in 1999, moving to TexasBank in 2000, as assistant vice president of marketing, where she served until her appointment as president and CEO of United Way of Denton County in 2006.

Bynum's vision for United Way of Denton County is to continue growing at a pace that keeps up with the growing needs of the community in the areas of education, income,

and health. She believes strongly in donor choice, in ensuring that donor contributions are properly attended to, and in managing a transparent organization where everyone is encouraged to know how things are done. Bynum notes that, "once you are volunteering or working for United Way, it quickly becomes a passion..." and she enjoys working with others who share her passion for the community.

Bynum has been involved in many community organizations since 1998. She is currently involved with the Denton Chamber of Commerce, serving on their board of directors, the University of North Texas, College of Public Affairs and Community Service Advisory Board, the North Central Texas Workforce Development Board, the Noon Rotary Club, and the Denton Benefit League.

Bynum has received several community awards including, the Denton Chamber Volunteer of the Year Award in 2003; the Denton Chamber Star Award in 1998 and 2009; Denton SHRM Pyramid Award in 1998, and the Leadership Denton Alumni Rookie of the Year Award in 2001.
