TWU's Beth Jillson recounts hoops career



Texas Woman's University head basketball coach Beth Jillson will be the featured speaker at Rotary Denton's

A native of Fort Worth, Texas, Jillson played college basketball at Weatherford (Texas) College for two seasons (1997-99). She then moved on to play two more years (1999-01) at Hardin Simmons University in Abilene, Texas. A talented shooting guard, Jillson served as team captain and helped lead her team to the NCAA Division III Elite Eight in 2000. She also earned American Southwest All-Conference and Academic All-Conference honors in 2001. After completing her playing career in the winter of 2001, Jillson stayed with the HSU program as the Cowgirls' student assistant coach for the 2001-02 season. In the spring of 2002, she completed her bachelor's degree in behavioral science and briefly filled the role as HSU's interim head coach before leaving for Oklahoma State.

Oct. 30 meeting. The 2008-09 season will be Jillson's second as head coach. Last season her TWU squad won four of their final five games during her first season to post a 12-15 record and match their second-highest conference win total (seven) in the program's 19 seasons of Lone Star Conference play.

Jillson came to TWU on August 17, 2007, with extensive experience in collegiate basketball coaching and administration. For a year prior to arriving at TWU, she was the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Charleston Southern University, an NCAA Division I school in Charleston, South Carolina. She has served as the assistant coach at New Mexico Junior College in Hobbs, New Mexico (2005-06); as the Oklahoma State University Cowgirls' graduate assistant coach (2002-03); and OSU's director of basketball operations (2003-05). She earned a Master of Science degree in exercise science from OSU in May 2005.

Dear Eva and Rotary of Denton Members,

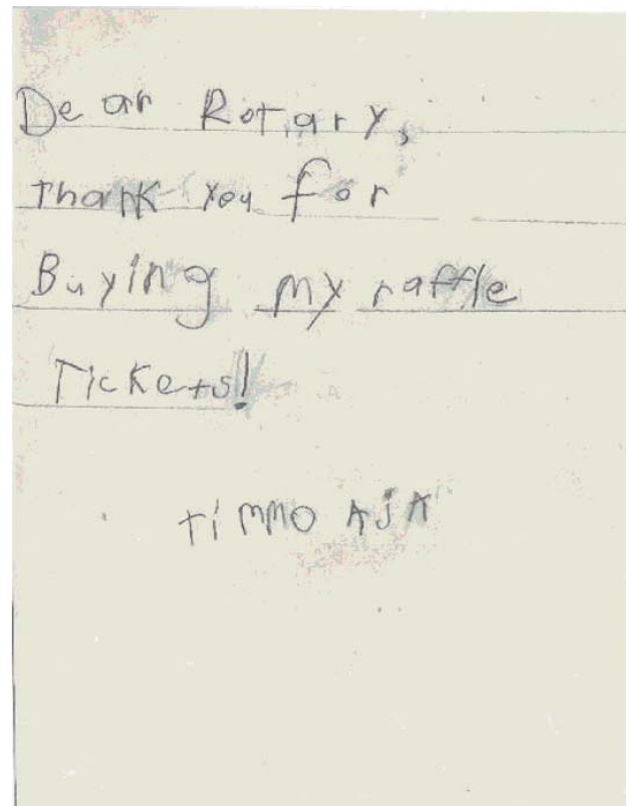
This is a thank you note from Timothy Aja (Ah-ha), the Ponder Elementary first grader who sold raffle tickets at Rotary a few weeks ago.

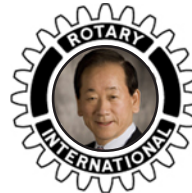

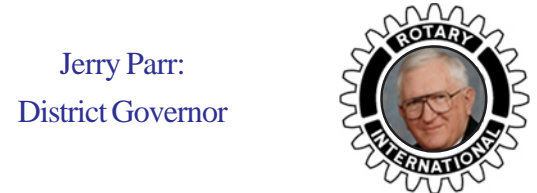

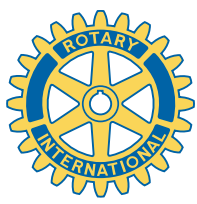
