Rep. Burgess visits Denton Rotary

U.S. Congressman Michael C. Burgess, an obstetrician from Lewisville, will address the Oct. 9 meeting of Denton Rotary. Among those voting no in the Oct. 3 House vote on the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008, Burgess told the Dallas Morning News that his opposition was based on what he was hearing from his constituents.

Burgess was elected to Congress in 2002 after 21 years working as a physician and, as he frequently boasts, delivering more than 3,000 babies. He serves on the House Energy and Commerce Committee. He is also vice chair of the House Republican Policy Committee which serves as a formal council to formulate and implement national legislative priorities, and to improve relationships between the executive and legislative branches of government.

He names as legislative priorities modernizing the US health care system, building a strong defense and homeland security, cutting the federal budget, reforming the tax code, and promoting energy self-sufficiency.

A UNT alumnus, Burgess earned his MD from the University of Texas Medical School in Houston and, in 2000, a masters degree in medical management from the University of Texas at Dallas.

Rotary South fountain dedicated Oct. 16

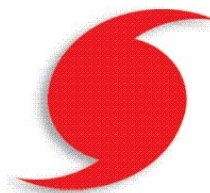

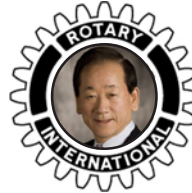

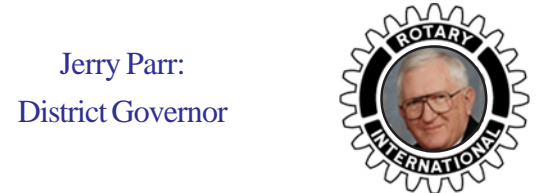
