### Live United campaign begins Thursday



Rotary Club of Denton will not meet on Thursday, Sept. 18 so that all members can attend the kick-off of the 2008 United Way fund-raising campaign. The campaign will celebrate its official launch at a lunch in the Gateway Center at the University of North Texas. The agency has set a goal of \$2,380,000.

New Denton Rotarian Todd Price is chair of the 2008 United Way campaign which takes "Live United" as its theme. Said Price, "United Way exists to change people's lives, and I challenge you to join us in making a positive community impact. A variety of opportunities await your commitment and action. Whether it is making a personal donation, a corporate gift, hosting an employee campaign or serving on a campaign cabinet committee, I invite you to make your mark in our campaign. Let's make it great in 2008, for everyone to live differently...Live United!"



United Way is targeting three critical impact areas which are building blocks for a good life:

- **Education** - Preparing children and youth to be successful after high school
- **Income** - Increasing the number of families that are financially stable
- **Health** - Increasing the number of individuals who are healthy and avoid risky behaviors

In implementing the campaign, United Way of Denton County is focusing on five target areas:

- Increasing self-sufficiency
- Helping children and youth succeed
- Strengthening families
- Promoting health and wellness
- Emergency and disaster relief for the hungry and homeless

## Rotary Group Study Exchange (GSE) seeks applicants

Once again Rotary District 5790 GSE co-chairs Josué Muñoz and Dean Peyton are asking for help in identifying applicants for the Rotary Group Study Exchange (GSE) which will take place next year with Mexico.

The GSE scholarship is an all-expenses-paid professional exchange. The GSE team will visit Mexico from April 26 - May 23, 2009 and will visit the Central Mexican states of Michoacán, Queretaro, Guanajuato, and parts of Jalisco and Hidalgo.

GSE team members are young professionals who meet the following requirements:

- Must be between 25 and 40 years of age
- Must be able to travel for four weeks, April 26 – May 23, 2009
- Not be a Rotarian or direct descendent of a Rotarian, mother, father, grandfather, etc cannot be a Rotarian
- Must either live or work in Rotary District 5790
- Have worked in their profession for at least two years
- Have a good knowledge of Spanish

(The application asks for a club sponsor and a club president signature; once an application is received Josué Muñoz will obtain the signature from a club.)

# Reduce childhood mortality? You can help

**R**otary International President D.K. Lee has challenged Rotarians worldwide to help reduce childhood mortality. The booklet *Things You Can Do* is a new reference guide to help individual Rotarians, clubs and districts work with the Rotarian Action Groups to help reduce childhood mortality, per President D. K. Lee's request. It's full of ways that we can help without reinventing the wheel. The following is an excerpt:

Rotary International has launched a new resource, ProjectLINK, an on-line, searchable database which lists Rotary club and district community service projects in need of funding, volunteers, donated goods,

and/or partners for a Rotary Foundation Matching Grant, and completed projects that can be used as examples of best practices. Rotarians can search for projects by country, project type, requirements, project status (completed or in need of assistance) or key word. ProjectLINK is available via the RI web site and is updated monthly.

### HOW CAN MY CLUB REGISTER A PROJECT ON PROJECTLINK?

A Rotary club with a community service project that needs assistance may register it with ProjectLINK by either filling out a WCS Project Data Form (784) or a Rotary Volunteers International Volunteer Site Data Form (285) and sending it to RI World Headquarters or the international office in the club's area.

### HOW DOES A CLUB SUPPORT A PROJECT LISTED ON PROJECTLINK?

Clubs looking for community service projects to support may select those that interest them from ProjectLINK. Then, they can write directly to the project contacts for more information.

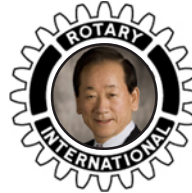

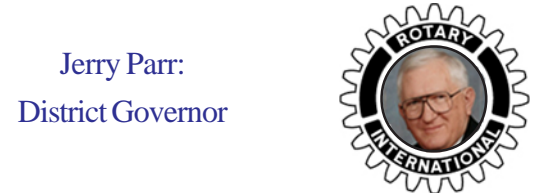

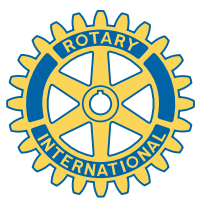
