We begin September “New Generations Month” with many exciting programs underway to address the younger generation! Inbound youth exchange students have arrived and are getting settled in their new homes and outbound students have departed as young ambassadors to many different countries. These experiences will provide an incredible international perspective and understanding that will last a life time and do much to promote goodwill and peace.

INTERACT and ROTARACT clubs are meeting and making their service and fellowship plans. Some clubs are even exploring the EarlyACT program for youth in grade school. Many clubs have dictionaries, books and reading programs underway and even “books for babies.”

Our ambassadorial scholars Vanessa and Marcelo have recently departed for Mexico and Chile to begin their diplomatic activities and international studies. Also our district will again have a two year Peace Fellow scholar studying in Australia. In a few days, candidates will be interviewing for the Group Study Exchange with Auckland, New Zealand.

Our Rotarians are also active in many initiatives which insure better health, nutrition and education for youth in our own communities but also in the world community. So far 28 of the 65 required annual governor club visits have been completed. I would like to thank all of you who participated in the very successful district seminar last month aimed at effective membership recruiting, retention and extension. The seminar also provided excellent individual “how to” training on many of the programs and features of the Rotary Foundation.

Oklahoma City club meets in a pub

Working for a politician in Oklahoma, USA, Mark Mann had been to plenty of civic group meetings. So when a friend asked him to consider joining a Rotary club in their town, he was anything but enthusiastic.

“I said, you have to have lost your mind,” Mann recalls. But the friend returned a few weeks later insisting that the Rotary Club of Bricktown Oklahoma City was different. “We don’t sing, they have great speakers, and they have great community service projects,” the friend said.

“I tried it out for a couple of weeks and decided it was a good fit for me,” says Mann, who is now serving as the club’s president. “I’ve been there ever since.”

The Bricktown Oklahoma City club marked its seventh anniversary on 11 September, with more than 60 members and an average age of 35. Mann and past club president Lealon Taylor point to several key ingredients that have helped the club attract and retain young members. For starters, the club meets in a pub. First-time guests are treated to two free beverages, compliments of the club.

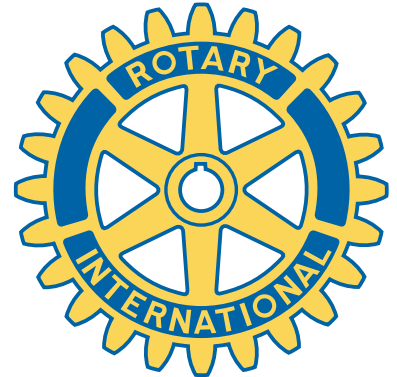

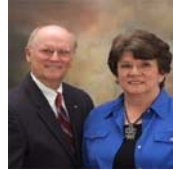
