Rotary hosts Denton police chief Sept. 4



Chief Roy W. Minter Jr., who was sworn in as the Denton chief of police on August 13, 2007, will address the Denton Rotary Club on Sept. 4.

When he was hired, Chief Minter commented, "I believe every organization needs four components to be successful: good people, good training, good policies and good leadership. I am extremely fortunate to have been selected to lead an organization that already has all four of these components in place.

"The Denton Police Department has a long tradition of being one of the most professional and innovative law enforcement agencies in the country. One of my primary goals as chief will be to manage our

resources to accomplish the operational and organizational mission of the agency based on accountability standards and performance expectations set forth by the mayor, city council, city manager and members of our great community."

Chief Minter began his law enforcement career with the Houston Police Department, where he served for 10 years as a police officer in the special operations division/tactical services bureau.

In 1992, he joined the Aurora, Colorado police department where he served for 15 years and rose to the rank of district commander.

Chief Minter holds a bachelor's degree in business administration and a master's degree in organizational management from the University of Phoenix.

Chief Minter is also a graduate of the Police Executive Research Forum - Senior Management Institute for Police - Executive Strategic Management Course.

He also holds instructor certifications for prevention and deterrence of terrorist acts; advanced ethics, and anti-biased policing.

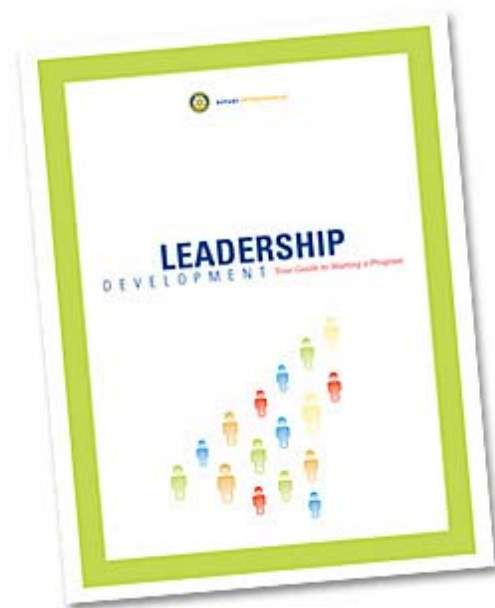

REDI Conference Dec. 5-6

All Rotarians are invited to attend the third annual conference and workshop for the North American Rotary Emergency Disaster Initiative, or REDI, jointly sponsored with the Disaster Relief Rotarian Action Group (DRRAG - www.rghf.org/drrag/). The event will be attended by all six North American Rotary International directors.

Natural disasters can happen anywhere and at anytime. Rotary clubs in disaster areas are

often times looked upon as secondary relief responders. Does your club have the tools to prepare for the worst? What is Rotary's role in disaster relief?

At the conference, Rotarians will learn from disaster relief professionals on ways to best prepare for natural disasters, as well as how best to respond to community needs.

The gathering will be held in Nassau, the Bahamas December 5-6 at the Sheraton Cable Beach Resort. Registration for the conference is \$195 until Oct. 31, when it rises to \$225. Room rates of \$132 will apply three days before and after the conference.

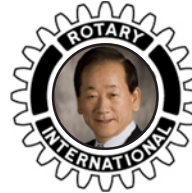

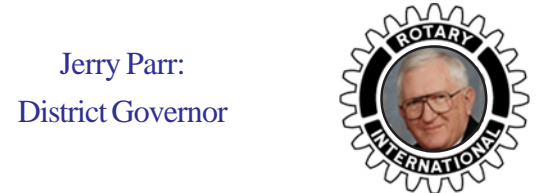

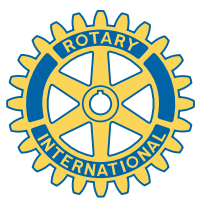
