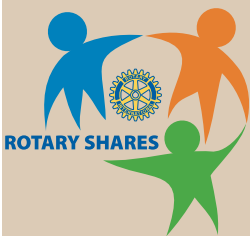

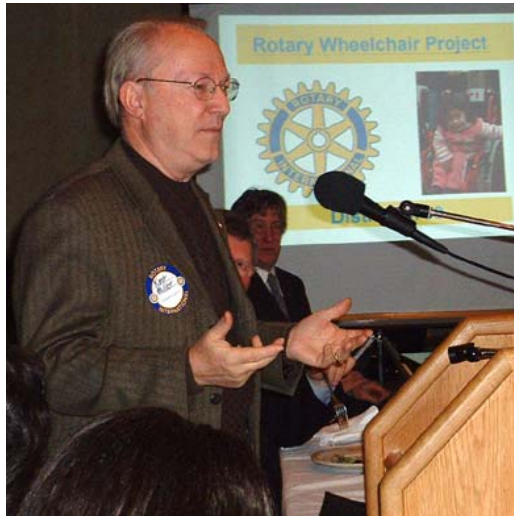

Wheels in Motion



Kent Miller

Our speaker last week was Kent Miller, who gave a visual presentation outlining Rotary's wheelchair distribution project in Peru.

Back from a July trip to the South American country, Kent reported on the accomplishments of *Rotary: Humanity in Motion*, which provides the gift of mobility in the form of wheelchairs. He brought to life the people living in the colonias of Lima with photos and vivid descriptions of their responses to Rotary team members.

The partnership among Rotarians in Peru and in the U.S. is transforming lives, both in the colonias and in Rotary. The Denton Rotary Club has helped the district surpass the fundraising goal for the wheelchair project. The goal was to send one wheelchair container to Peru for \$21,000. In fact, the amount raised was \$44,000, which allowed for the shipment of a second container to Leon, Mexico. It was delivered the first week of September, 2007.

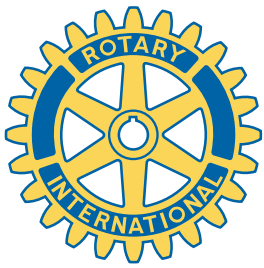
