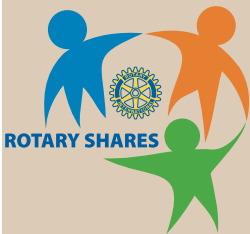

Always Pointing Up: Tetra Point Fuels (you had to be there to get the reference)

Tim Geiger, president of Tetra Point Fuels, and Chris Ball, let us know how they will be creating ethanol from expired or defective sugar-based liquids, such as soda, sports drinks and beer that would otherwise be routed to a landfill.

All the containers will also be recycled and even the yeast and residue that is part of the fermentation process will end up as fertilizer.

Looks like they will be underway by the end of the summer and will be producing 8 million gallons of ethanol. Additional plants

are also planned and will be located near major metropolitan areas where there are bottling and distribution centers. Sources for the plants will need to be within 150 miles.

The headquarters and processing plant is headquartered at Granite Point Industrial Park at Interstate 35W and Metro Street and has 61,000 sq.ft. Both Tim and Chris emphasized how pleased they were with being in Denton and the positive relationship they have with UNT, which is involved in bioresearch.

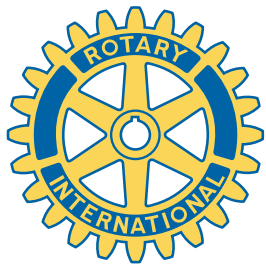
