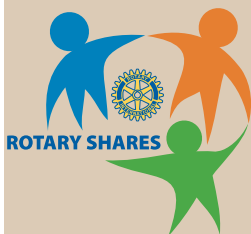

## Building Character

At last week's meeting UNT Defensive Coach Chuck Peterson gave an update and a look ahead for the UNT Football team. He pointed out that, win or lose, he felt they were accomplishing the task of character building. He also said most of the teams they will be playing the rest of they year will be comparable to the current skill and experience level of the UNT players.



Coach Peterson was a coach at Air Force for many years and thought he wouldn't have to see Navy again. As a result he thought God was getting back at him when he came to UNT and found out that North Texas would be playing Navy this year.

He discussed the advantages of moving from coaching offense at Air Force to defense. He found it was somewhat of an advantage for him, but it was also a challenge for the players to get comfortable with a new defensive concept.

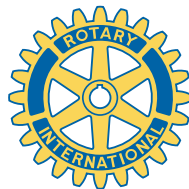

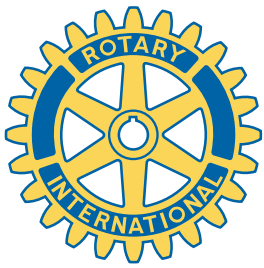
